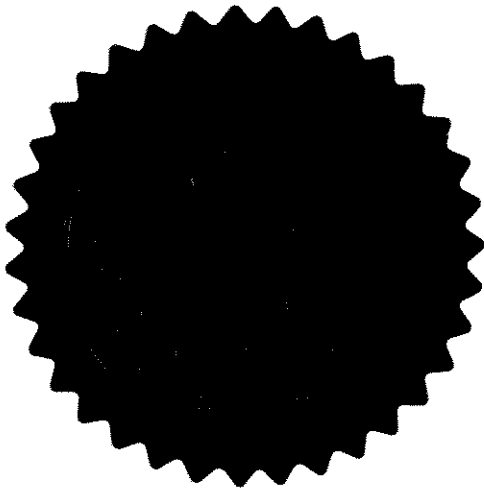
An Order showing the modifications to the University College's Instrument is enclosed. The modifications to the Articles of Government that were resolved by the University on 9th July 2007 have also been approved.

In accordance with section 124A(3) of the Education Reform Act 1988^(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the Privy Council by Order dated 21st May 1993 made a instrument of government for the Buckinghamshire College of Higher Education, being a higher education corporation with respect to which Schedule 7 to the Act has effect:

And in accordance with section 124A(3)(b) of the Act, the Privy Council made an Order dated 13th November 2000 modifying the Corporation's Instrument to include a change of title to Buckinghamshire Chilterns University College higher education corporation:

Section 124A(3)(b) of the Act provides that the Privy Council may by Order modify an instrument of government of any such higher education corporation:

In accordance with the instrument of government, the Corporation have changed their name with the consent of the Privy Council:
