



Vice Chancellor PhD Studentship Awards

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Doctoral awards at Buckinghamshire New University are awarded by Staffordshire University (our validating partner).
- The award covers full-time tuition fees for a maximum period of three years. Students who do not complete within this period will then be liable for tuition fees at the full-time rate - at: <https://www.bucks.ac.uk/research/graduate-school>
- The award includes a bursary for up to three years. The bursary is payable directly into a bank or building society account at the end of each calendar month. The bursary amount will be fixed at the time of application with details published on the website.
- Home, EU and International external candidates may apply for the Studentships.
- Applicants must satisfy all entry criteria for Doctoral candidates and be accepted through the normal application process with approval from Staffordshire University, to be eligible for an award.
- Continued enrolment and funding is subject to achievement of satisfactory progress evidenced at annual progression review meetings.

Criteria of award

Applications will be judged on the following:

- Quality and likelihood of success of research proposal
- Alignment with Buckinghamshire New University's key research areas
- Personal justification for wishing to undertake the award
- A consideration of widening participation access criteria

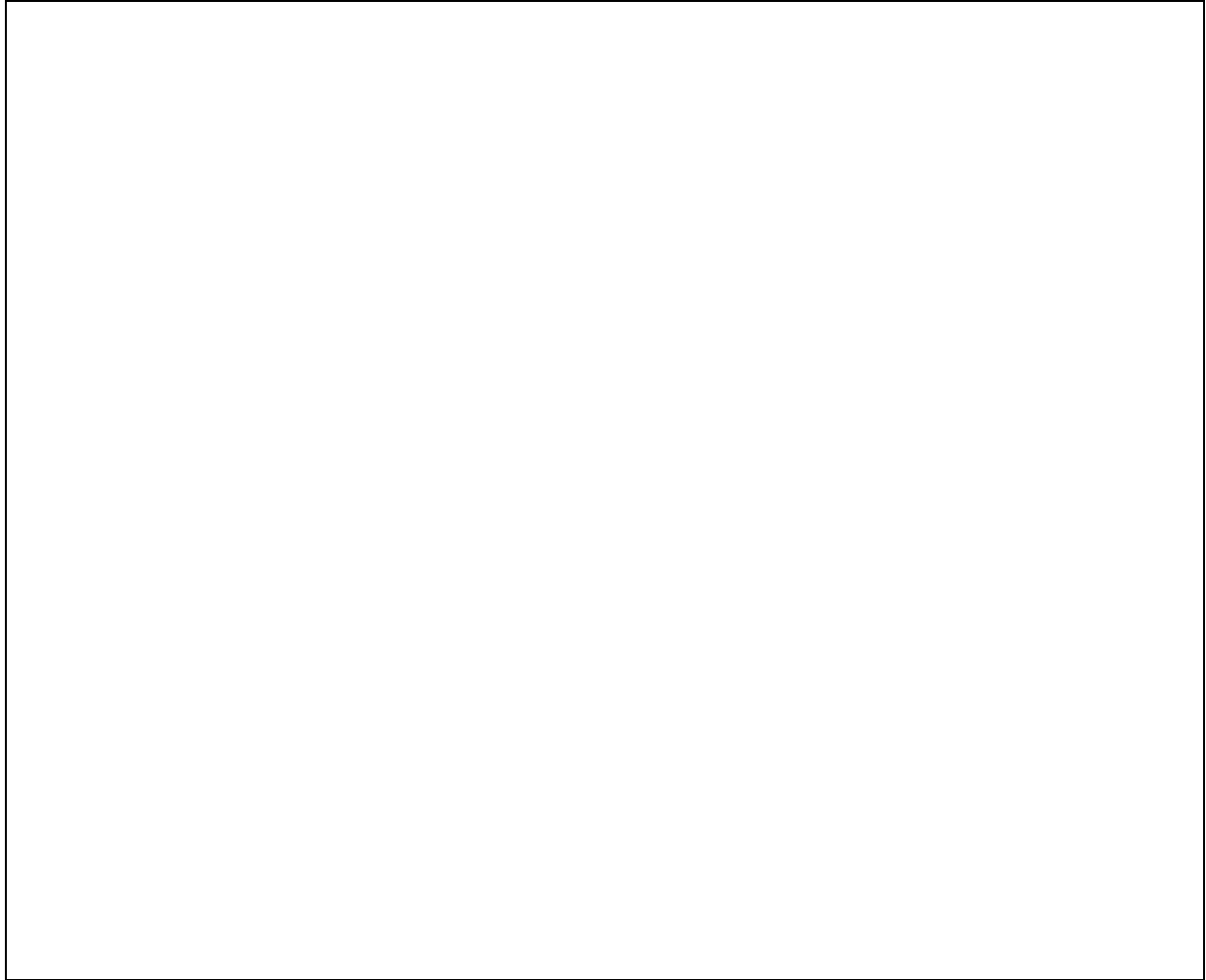
