This is a snapshot of Bucks New University Student population derived from the data submitted to HESA as at the end of the academic year 2016/17.

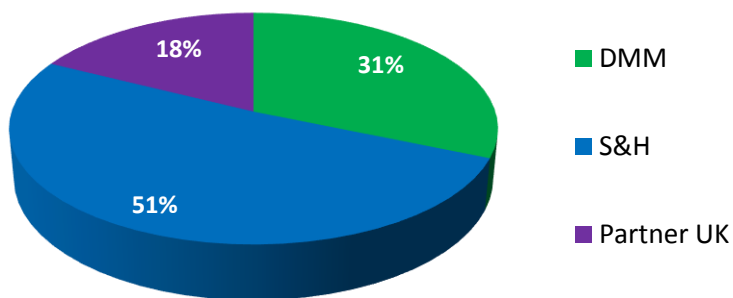
Notes to the data:

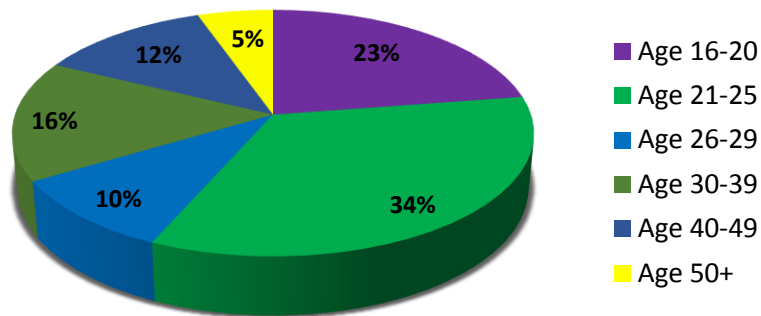

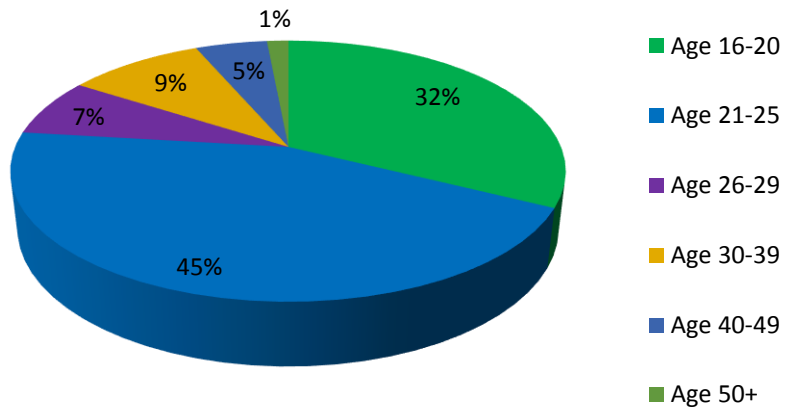

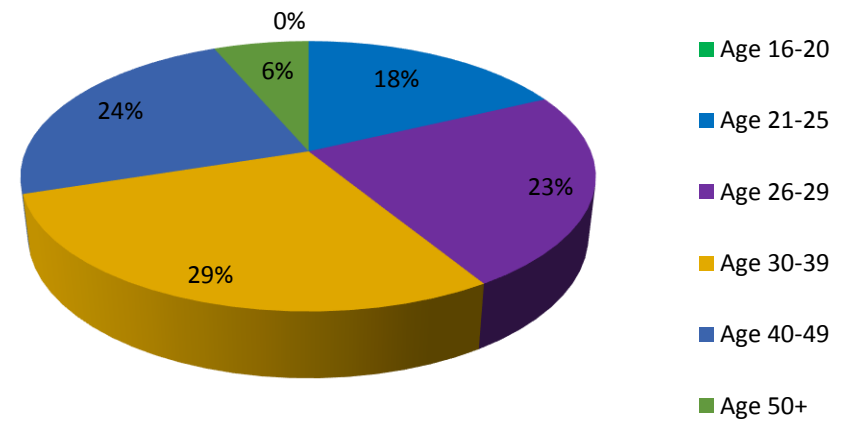

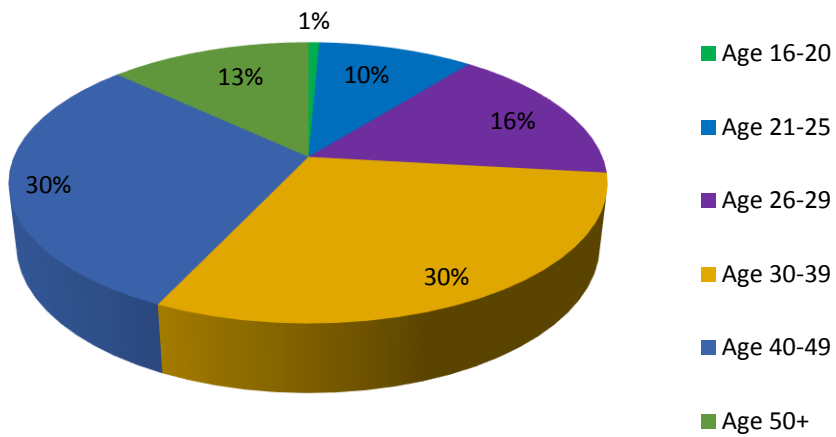
Full time undergraduates: by age group



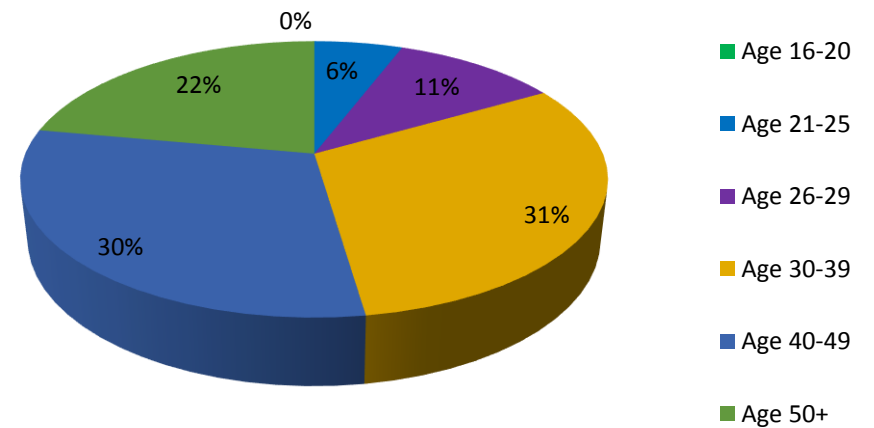
Full time time postgraduates: by age group



Part time time undergraduates: by age group

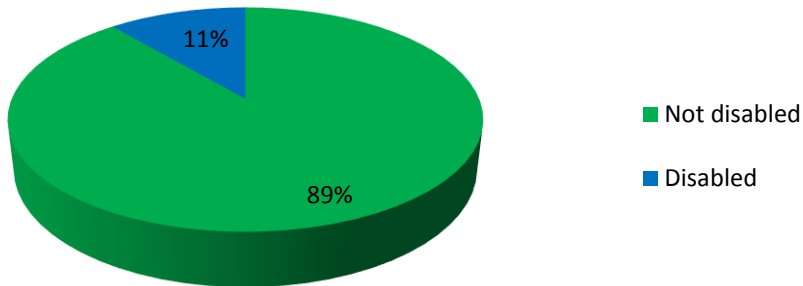


Part time time postgraduates: by age group



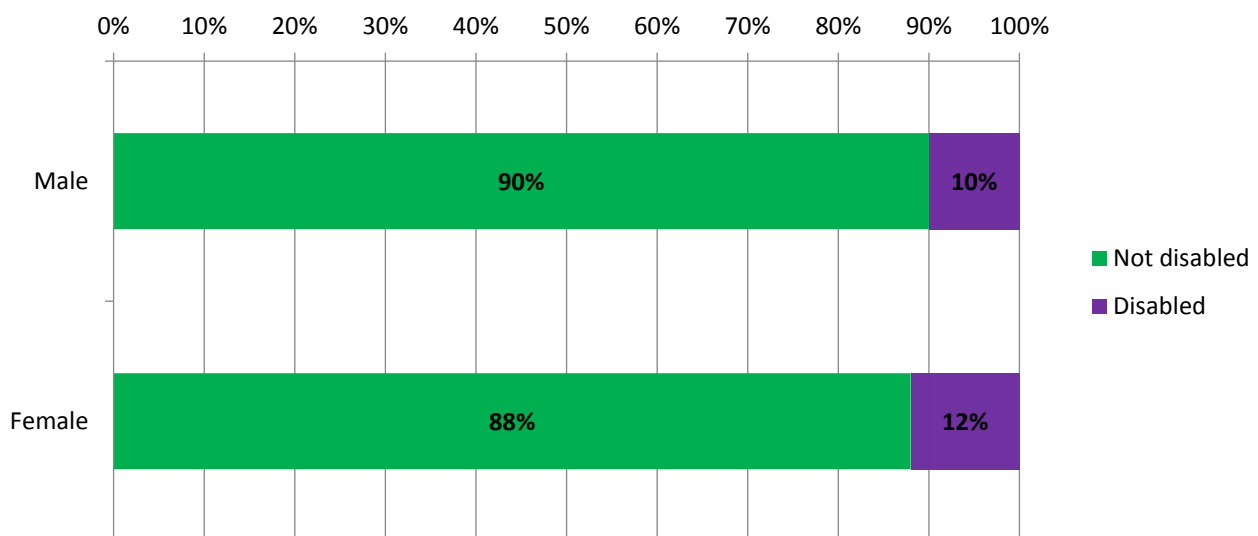
