



2017/2018 Additional Study Costs and Charges for Undergraduate Courses

All Courses

There are additional costs associated with all studies, which require consideration, when planning and budgeting for expenditure. The costs shown are for the **total length of the course** shown unless otherwise stated.

Books and other Text:

Students will be required to purchase texts and journals to support their study programme. The minimum, average cost of books for students studying on a degree course is assumed as £100 **per year**.

Printing:

We recommend a minimum budget of £50 **per year** for printing costs including dissertation printing and binding.

In year or end of year exhibitions, projects and performances:

Where a course contains exhibitions, major projects or performances additional costs will be incurred. These costs can be discussed in detail with your course teams and some will be linked to a professional skills element of the course where organised fundraising for such activities may be included.

Pilot Training

Courses which include flight training elements will incur additional costs from private or commercial training providers. These can be quite substantial; however planned payment schedules may be arranged. Full details of the costs involved can be supplied on request, please refer to your course page on the Bucks Website.

Graduation:

Graduation costs per student are estimated at £100 - £200 total. This is an optional cost for all students as attending graduation is not a requirement in order to have a degree conferred.
