



Additional Course Costs: BA (Hons) Textile Design

There are additional costs associated with all studies, which require consideration, when planning and budgeting for expenditure. The costs shown are for the **total length of the course** shown unless otherwise stated.

Books and other Texts:

Students may be required to purchase texts and journals to support their study programme. The minimum, average cost of books for students studying on a degree course is assumed as **£100 per year**.

Printing:

We recommend a minimum budget of **£50 per year** for printing costs including dissertation printing and binding. This relates to the printing of written documents through the photocopiers. Where relevant, the printing of artworks (draft and finished) will incur additional costs in the region of £100-£200 per year with a further optional £50-£100 per year.

Equipment/Material Costs

This is estimated at £300-£400, with up to £500 optional costs. The equipment and materials used are selected by the students so costs are variable.

In year or end of year exhibitions, projects and performances:

In year/end of year show costs could be in the region of £500-£600 with optional costs of up to £300. Fundraising towards the end of year exhibition is part of the student experience. All final year students are offered the chance to show their work at a venue in London over the summer.

Study Trips or Tours

Compulsory study tours/trips of up to £200 and a further £500 for optional tours and trips.

Graduation:

Graduation costs per student are estimated at £100 - £200 total. This is an optional cost for all students as attending graduation is not a requirement in order to have a degree conferred.
