



2017/2018 Additional Study Costs and Charges for Undergraduate Courses

All Courses

There are additional costs associated with all studies, which require consideration, when planning and budgeting for expenditure. The costs shown are for the **total length of the course** shown unless otherwise stated.

Books and other Text:

Students will be required to purchase texts and journals to support their study programme. The minimum, average cost of books for students studying on a degree course is assumed as £100 **per year**.

Printing:

We recommend a minimum budget of £50 **per year** for printing costs including dissertation printing and binding.

In year or end of year exhibitions, projects and performances:

Where a course contains exhibitions, major projects or performances additional costs will be incurred. These costs can be discussed in detail with your course teams and some will be linked to a professional skills element of the course where organised fundraising for such activities may be included.

Pilot Training

Courses which include flight training elements will incur additional costs from private or commercial training providers. These can be quite substantial; however planned payment schedules may be arranged. Full details of the costs involved can be supplied on request, please refer to your course page on the Bucks Website.

Graduation:

Graduation costs per student are estimated at £100 - £200 total. This is an optional cost for all students as attending graduation is not a requirement in order to have a degree conferred.

<p>BA (Hons) Fashion Design</p>	<p>Printing costs will be between £100-200, but a further £300-£400 may be needed depending on the student's choices on materials and research.</p> <p>Equipment/Materials costs of £100 to £200 for the course, with up to £800 further optional costs depending on student's choice of purchases in terms of: materials, printing, supplies and other equipment.</p> <p>Compulsory study tours and trips will be up to £100 with optional trips estimated up to £400.</p> <p>In year and end of year exhibition costs will be up to £200 with optional costs of £400 to £500.</p>

<p>BA (Hons) Graphic Arts BA (Hons) Graphic Design BA (Hons) Illustration</p>	<p>Compulsory books are estimated at £100 - £200 with optional costs a further £100 - £200.</p> <p>It is estimated that printing costs will be £50 - £100 for the course with optional costs of £200 - £300 costs depending on the nature of any project.</p> <p>For Equipment/Materials compulsory costs of £100 to £200 apply, with up to £900 further optional costs depending on student's choice of purchases in terms of: art supplies/materials, text books, stationery, computer/laptop, other equipment.</p> <p>Optional costs of up to £900 for study tours and trips. In year or end of year exhibition optional costs will be up to £200</p> <p>Other additional course costs £500 - £600 approximately for a second-hand MacBook laptop which some students find useful for Graphics based courses.</p>

<p>Foundation Degree (Arts) Kitchen Design</p>	<p>Compulsory book costs of £100 - £200 with optional costs of a further £100 - £200.</p> <p>Printing costs will be £50 - £100 for the course with a further £50 - £100 on optional printing</p> <p>Equipment/Materials optional costs of £100 to £200.</p> <p>Compulsory study tours and trips of £100 to £200.</p>

<p>BA (Hons) Product Design BSc (Hons) Product Design</p>	<p>Printing costs will be between £50 - £100 with optional printing up to a further £100</p> <p>Equipment/Material costs of £100 - £200, with up to £300 optional costs depending on student's choice of purchases in terms of: text books, stationery, computer/laptop, other equipment.</p> <p>Compulsory tours and trips of up to £100 with further optional trip costs up to £1000.</p> <p>Equipment/Studio and or Venue Hire costs of up to £100 with further optional costs of up to £200</p> <p>In year and end of year exhibitions costs up to £100 with further optional costs up to £200</p> <p>Additional costs from £0 - £100 may be required for course specific kit.</p>
<p>BA (Hons) Product Design: Interior Product</p>	<p>Printing costs of £50 - £100 with optional costs of £50 - £100 dependant on project content.</p> <p>Equipment/Materials compulsory costs of £100 - £200, with up to £400 optional costs depending on student's choice of purchases in terms of: text books, stationery, computer/laptop, other equipment.</p> <p>Compulsory tours and trips of up to £100 with further optional trips up to £1000.</p> <p>Equipment/Studio and or Venue Hire costs of up to £100 with further optional costs of up to £200</p> <p>In year and end of year exhibitions costs up to £100 with a further optional costs up to £200</p> <p>Additional costs from £0 - £100 may be required for: Course Specific kit.</p>

BA (Hons) Textiles and Surface Design

Book costs of £100 - £200 with further optional costs of £100 - £200. Recommended books are held in the University Library.

Printing costs of £100 - £200 with a further optional £50 - £100.

Equipment/Materials costs of £300 - £400, with up to £500 optional costs. This includes any textile printing costs. The equipment and materials used are selected by the students so costs are variable.

Compulsory study tours and trips of up to £200 and a further £500 for optional tours and trips.

In year/end of year show costs are £500 - £600 with optional costs up to £500.

Fundraising towards the end of year exhibition is embedded into the professional skills element of the course. This includes fund raising and setting up the Red Shed Society. All students are offered the chance to exhibit at New Designers, London rather than it being a selective show.
