Joining Online Sessions

Listen to the instructions of your lecturer, they will tell you if the session is going to be recorded and other activities that you may be participating in that will require you to turn on your microphone or video function.

How to Participate in a Blackboard Collaborate Session



- Open Session Menu** (Get help, leave session, etc.)
- Share Audio:** mute or unmute your microphone
Important: you must keep your microphone muted until asked to unmute.
- Collaborate Panel** (Online chatting, settings, etc.)
- Your settings, status, feedback, etc.**
- Start or stop your camera**
- Raise or lower your hand**
