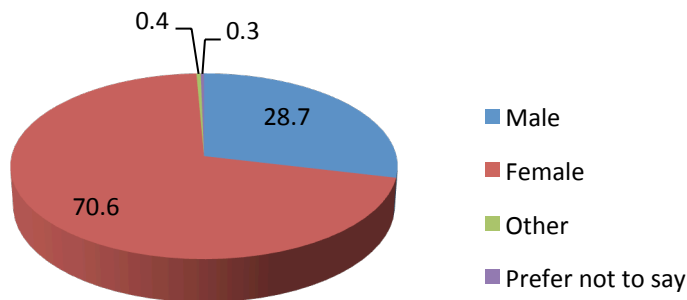


Student data on Sexual Orientation, Gender Identity Religion and Pregnancy and Maternity 2014/15

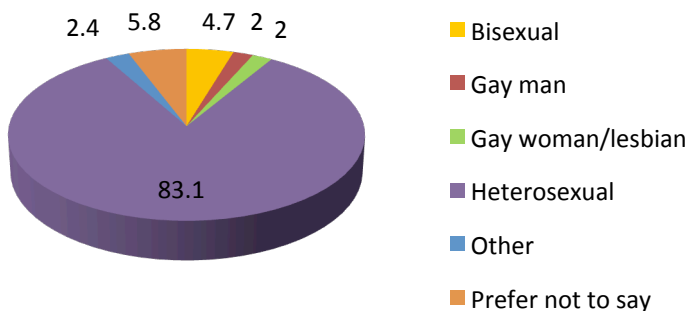
Whilst our current student systems do not allow us to collect data on the above characteristics we decided to try to obtain some baseline data by means of a survey until we are in a position to collect the data as part of the main enrolment process.

Our first survey produced 704 responses (11.4% of students) and approximately 70% of responses were from females.

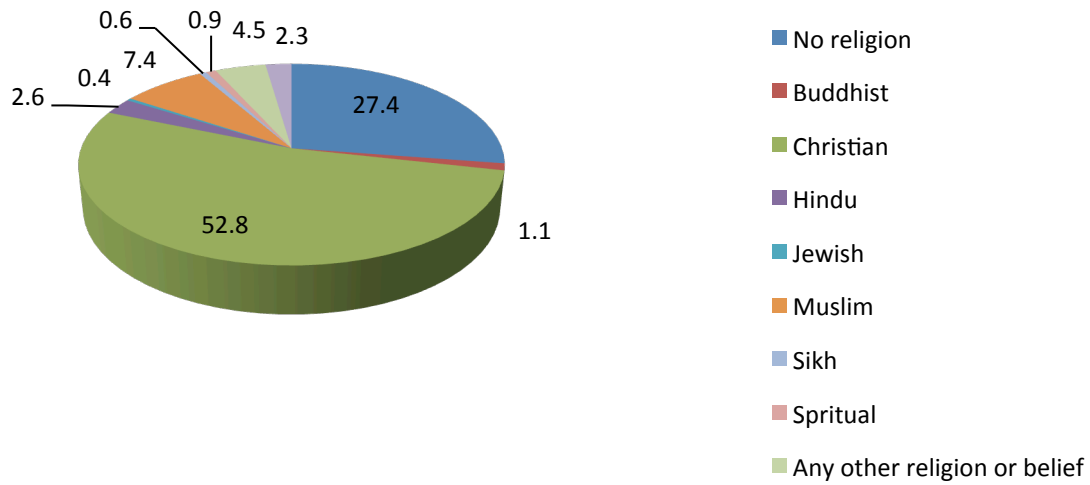


In terms of **Gender Identity** the responses were so low as to be statistically insignificant.

For **Sexual Orientation** 4% of respondents identified as being gay/lesbian whilst 4.7% identified as bisexual.



The responses to the question on **Religion** identified that 52.8% of respondents were Christians.



The questions we asked on **pregnancy and having given birth** within the last 26 weeks produced statistically insignificant results. However in response to questions about **dependents** 30% of respondents said they had a dependent aged 16 or under.
