



Additional Course Costs

There are additional costs associated with all studies, which require consideration, when planning and budgeting for expenditure. The costs shown are for the **total length of the course** shown unless otherwise stated.

Books and other Texts:

Students may be required to purchase texts and journals to support their study programme. The minimum, average cost of books for students studying on a degree course is assumed as **£100 per year**.

Printing:

We recommend a minimum budget of **£75 per year** for printing costs including dissertation printing and binding. This relates to the printing of written documents through the photocopiers. Where relevant, the printing of magazine work (draft and finished) will incur additional costs. Students should budget a further **£75 per year** for this.

Study Trips:

Students will need to pay for travel on study trips or visits which could cost up to **£200 per year**.

Graduation:

Graduation costs per student are estimated at **£100 - £200 total**. This is an optional cost for all students as attending graduation is not a requirement in order to have a degree conferred.
