

# Buckinghamshire New University Interview Guidance

## Dance



**Admissions will inform you if you have been selected for audition/interview. You will then be invited to send through an audition video and attend an online interview with the course team**

Please read carefully the following information regarding your audition/ interview: -

### **Audition/ Interview Process (for Home and Overseas students)**

In replacement of a live audition, this year due to Covid, we are inviting applicants to prepare an audition video. We would like to see you dancing in a solo/group piece (if it is a group piece, please indicate which dancer you are) of around 1.5 to 2 minutes in length. This can be in any dance style but please ensure it showcases your technique – flexibility, strength, stamina and alignment. This can be emailed directly to the course leader Lauren Vincent at [lauren.vincent@bucks.ac.uk](mailto:lauren.vincent@bucks.ac.uk) you could send this as an attachment, a link to a recording on YouTube for example, or via WeTransfer/ One Drive if the link is too large. We will be watching the video audition and rather than looking specifically at your proficiency in the dance style, we are looking for students who are open-minded, who have potential and who would benefit from completing the dance degree course.

Please also email through a piece of written work you have completed (at school/college for example, it doesn't need to be dance-related) as a demonstration of your academic writing style.

Following receipt of your audition video and piece of written work, the course leader will email you to set up an online interview on a mutually convenient date and time. The interview is a chance for us to find out your aspirations, reasons for wishing to study here at Bucks and for you to ask us any questions that you may have about the course.
