# Joining Online Sessions



Join sessions early to check your audio and video settings are functioning properly.



Depending on what device you're using, you may have a preferred browser. However, for Blackboard Collaborate we strongly recommend Google Chrome.



To improve your connection to online sessions, turn off other applications that you do not need.



Listen to the instructions of your lecturer, they will tell you if the session is going to be recorded and other activities that you may be participating in that will require you to turn on your microphone or video function.

## How to Participate in a Blackboard Collaborate Session



Open Session Menu (Get help, leave session, etc.)

Share Audio: mute or unmute your microphone  
**Important:** you must keep your microphone muted until asked to unmute.

Collaborate Panel (Online chatting, settings, etc.)

Your settings, status, feedback, etc.

Start or stop your camera

Raise or lower your hand
