## Additional Course Costs - Interior \& Spatial Design

There are additional costs associated with all studies, which require consideration, when planning and budgeting for expenditure. The costs shown are for the total length of the course shown unless otherwise stated.

## Books and other Texts:

Students may be required to purchase texts and journals to support their study programme. The minimum, average cost of books for students studying on a degree course is assumed as $£ 100$ per year.

## Printing:

We recommend a minimum budget of $£ 50$ per year for printing costs including dissertation printing and binding. This relates to the printing of written documents through the photocopiers. Where relevant, the printing of artworks (draft and finished) will incur additional costs listed below.

## In year or end of year exhibitions, projects and performances:

Where a course contains exhibitions, major projects or performances additional costs will be incurred. These costs can be discussed in detail with your course teams and some will be linked to a professional skills element of the course where organised fundraising for such activities may be included.

## Graduation:

Graduation costs per student are estimated at $£ 100$ - $£ 200$ total. This is an optional cost for all students as attending graduation is not a requirement in order to have a degree conferred.
Any additional costs over and above those listed above can be found listed below:

## Equipment and Materials:

One off equipment/materials costs of $£ 150-£ 200$ in the beginning of first, with up to $£ 300$ further optional costs depending on student's choice of purchases in terms of: art supplies/materials, stationery, and other equipment. Details of these included in course joining instructions.

## Study Tours/Trips:

Costs of $£ 100$ with optional costs from $£ 400$ to $£ 900$ for overseas study tours and trips.

## PC Laptop Computer (Optional):

Costs from $£ 500$ to $£ 1000$.

End of Year Exhibitions:
In year and end of year exhibitions optional costs up to $£ 400$ plus additional materials costs.
