Entry Requirements

Entry Point A: Foundation Year

A minimum of two GCSEs or equivalent.

For applicants from non-majority English speaking countries, an overall IELTS score of 5.5 is expected, with a 5 for all the individual elements.

Mature student (21 years or over) may be accepted on the basis of relevant work and/or life experience. These students would normally be required to provide the following evidence: Candidate CV, Personal Statement and evidence of work in a Work Portfolio.

Entry Point B: Year 1 – BA (Hons) Business Management

A minimum of two full A-levels (or equivalent) is required.

For applicants from non-majority English speaking countries, an overall IELTS score of 6 is expected, with a 5.5 for all the individual elements.

Applicants who do not meet the minimum requirements for the three-year undergraduate programme, or those who do not feel fully prepared for a degree course, can apply for a four-year programme including a Foundation Year.
